GENERAL INFORMATION

Thymic® controls insect, fungi and bacterial pathogens and is safe on all crops, ornamental plants and turf. Thymic contains thyme oil and directly suffocates and destroys the cell membranes of pests. Pests are not likely to develop resistance to Thymic due to the mode of action, making it suitable for use as part of an integrated pesticide resistance management program. Thymic has no re-entry or preharvest intervals and can be applied the day of harvest.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use Thymic to control pests any time during the season. Apply Thymic to the crop foliage every 7 to 10 days as necessary repeating applications to maintain the desired level of control. Apply Thymic in a minimum of 0.25% v/v concentration in a sufficient volume to ensure uniform and complete coverage of the treated area. Thymic is tank mix compatible with a range of dormant oils, fertilizers and other plant protectants. Thymic is safe for application in the field, greenhouse and interior spaces wherever plants are grown.

Apply to the soil for nematode prevention and control. Repeat application every 10-15 days until pressure subsides.
